

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE SECTION 93

AN ORDINANCES DEALING WITH THE REGULATION OF STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

Findings.

1. The Browns Valley City Council has adopted the Minnesota Basic Code as it has been amended and supplemented to be its city code; and
2. That code permits the City of Browns Valley to regulate the usage of streets and sidewalks within the City of Browns Valley for the betterment of all Browns Valley residents.
3. The Browns Valley City Council believes it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Browns Valley to modify its Ordinance regulating the use of streets and sidewalks.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROWNS VALLEY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Browns Valley City Ordinance Section 93 is hereby amended to add the following provision:

“93.04. OBSTRUCTION OF STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

(A) No person shall in any manner or at any time obstruct the traffic on any public street or road.

(B) No person or persons shall stand or congregate upon the sidewalks or crosswalks of the City of Browns Valley in such manner as to unnecessarily interfere with the free passage of pedestrians along the same. It shall be the duty of law enforcement officers to notify all persons unnecessarily obstructing said sidewalks or crosswalks, as hereinbefore set forth, to pass along and cease obstructing the same.”
