

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE SECTION 30.08

**AN ORDINANCE DEALING WITH COMPENSATION OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS
IN THE CITY OF BROWNS VALLEY**

Findings.

1. The existing Ordinance sets the regular compensation for the Mayor and each City Council member.
2. Said compensation has not been adjusted since 2010 when the new City Code was adopted.
3. The Browns Valley City Council believes that it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Browns Valley to modify its Ordinance to increase the compensation for the positions of Mayor and City Council in order to attract highly qualified candidates for each position.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROWNS VALLEY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Browns Valley City Ordinance Section 30.08 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“30.08 COMPENSATION OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL MEMBERS

Compensation of the Mayor and member of the City Council shall be established from time to time by City Council Ordinance, pursuant to M.S.A. §415.11, as it may be amended from time to time. Said compensation is hereby set as follows:

(A) Positions.

- (1) Mayor. The Mayor shall receive the sum of \$2,400 per year, calculated at \$100 per meeting.
- (2) Vice-Mayor. The Vice-Mayor shall receive the same compensation as the Mayor during the time he or she is acting as Mayor.
- (3) City Council. Each member of the City Council shall receive the sum of \$1,440 per year, calculated at \$60 per meeting.

(B) Miscellaneous Provisions.

- (1) Compensation shall be included with the November payroll, covering December 1 from the previous year through November 30 of that year.
- (2) If an individual misses more than three (3) council meetings in a calendar year, that member shall be docked for each missed meeting after the third missed meeting. If an individual misses more than six (6) meetings in a calendar year, that member shall have their total annual compensation docked by one-half.
- (3) For any other meetings the Mayor or a member of the City Council attends, that individual shall receive compensation in the amount of \$50 per meeting. This includes special meetings and emergency meetings.
- (4) Any modifications to the salaries and per diems as herein provided shall be enacted by ordinance and shall take effect on the first day of January of the calendar year following a municipal general election.”
